STAMP COLLECTING MERIT BADGE WORKSHOP INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANT & PARENTS Saturday, January 20, 2018

1. Scout is to be on time. Class starts at 9:00 A.M.

- a. Follow signs from the parking lot to cafetorium @ Spring Valley High for merit badge workshop
- a. <u>Registration for stamp show is at front desk in lobby</u>. Get free door prize ticket when you sign in along with a free program about the show. Hourly door prizes will be awarded by the number on the ticket from random drawing on the hour.
- c. Recommend arriving at registration desk by NLT 8:45 AM;
- h. Class is in rear of cafetorium and area will be marked.
- i. There will be an additional registration for the merit badge in class area.

2. Information to furnish for <u>pre-registration</u> to Mr. Owen is requested as follows:

- a. (1) Full Name and nick-name; (2) Scout rank
- b. (1) Home address and (2) phone #
- c. DOB
- d. Parent's name(s)
- d. Troop # & sponsoring organization (church, civic group, etc.)
- e. District in which troop is located (Catawba, Chinquapin, Edisto, Etowah, Congaree, Wateree)
- f. E-mail pre-registration info back to Mr. Owen OR bring completed form with you.

3. What to bring

- a. Bag lunch and drink or money to purchase same from vending machines are located in foyer across from registration desk. Vending machines have drinks and snacks but NO sandwiches.
- b. \$10.00 registration fee for materials provided in class.
- c. Additional funds to purchase stamps from dealers other than those that will be offered free
- d. Merit badge book

4. Preparation

- a. <u>Study</u> the requirements and <u>read</u> the material by <u>ordering the mb book</u> from <u>Scout Shop</u> at Council office by <u>calling</u> @ 803-798-0389 to <u>place order ASAP</u>. If you cannot get a handbook. go to <u>MeritBadge.org</u> and print out information on stamp collecting mb.
- b. If you have a stamp collection or you are starting one, bring it with you.
- c. <u>Please wear your Scout uniform</u>. You will be taking a tour of the show including the exhibits so I prefer Scouts to be visible.
- d. Be prepared! It will make the class more interesting, help you ask questions and complete the requirements in a more efficient manner.

5. Twelve Points of Scout Law will be observed.

6. Time Schedule

- a. Registration and seating in work shop area: 9-9:15 AM. Please be on time.
- b. Lunch from 11:30 AM-12:15 PM which will include tour of show and exhibits.
- c. Work shop wrap up NLT 4:00 PM.

- 7. Materials will be provided as those addressed in mb book: tongs, perforation gauge, glassine envelopes, magnifiers, hinges, other mounting materials, stamps, envelopes, pencils/pens; merit badge requirement guide sheets in folder; resources include Scott catalogs, philatelic literature, handouts, etc.
- 8. **READ & STUDY requirement #8**. You will have to decide which option you will want to complete. <u>The topical collection is the fastest to complete ON SITE but not the only one</u>. If you do not complete #8 at the work shop, <u>you will have 30 days to do so</u>. You will call and make an appointment with Mr. Owen to meet and review what you have done to complete #8 in order for your merit badge blue card to be completed and signed off by Mr. Owen. This will be a "fast paced workshop." <u>Participants need to be prepared!</u>

- 10. PRE-REGISTRATION IS PREFERRABLE. IF MAXIUM # SCOUTS IS REACHED, YOU MAY BE PLACED ON A WAITING LIST. Stamp collection merit badge is held twice yearly, same location in January and August.
