# Scouts will get their U.S. stamp in 2010

The United States Postal Service finally confirmed on Nov. 5 that it will issue a stamp in 2010 to recognize 100 years of Scouting in America.

Linn's Stamp News reported in the Aug. 14 issue that a U.S. stamp honoring Scouts

The Boy Scouts of America cite Feb. 8, 1910, as its date of incorporation, and has posted a web site banner celebrating "100 Years of Scouting."

March 12, 1912, is the date Girl Scouts of America was founded.

The Celebrate Scouting design is to be revealed publicly at 10 a.m. on Nov. 12 at the Smithsonian National Postal Museum in Washington, D.C., according to the Postal Service.

We expect to picture the design in next week's issue of Linn's Stamp News.

The stamp's illustration by Craig Frazier of Mill Valley, Calif., reportedly depicts the images of two different Scouts.

I think it's a safe guess that we will see a Boy Scout and a Girl Scout on the new stamp, but we'll know for sure next week.

Rules and guidelines are no doubt a necessity when it comes to selecting subjects for U.S. stamps, but I'm glad the Postal Service

This won't be the first Scouting by any means. There have been quite a few over the years, including a nice honor for Boy Scouts

1998 on a 32¢ stamp in the Celebrate the Century series (Scott 3183j).

Both Scouting groups will be honored on U.S. coins in their respective centennial years, as well.

In October 2008, President George W. Bush signed into law the Boy Scouts of America Centennial Commemorative Coin Act authorizing the minting of 350,000 silver dollars to celebrate the 2010 anniversary.

On Oct. 29 this year, President Barack Obama signed similar legislation to create a Girl Scouts silver dollar for release in 2012.
