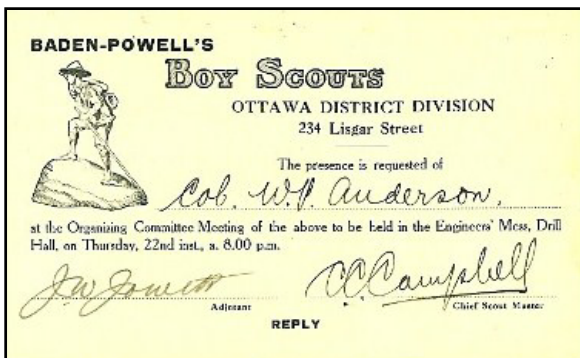

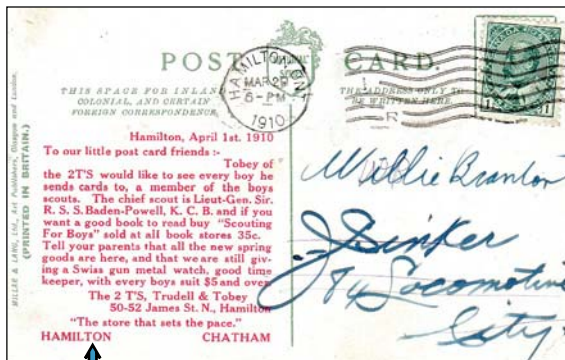

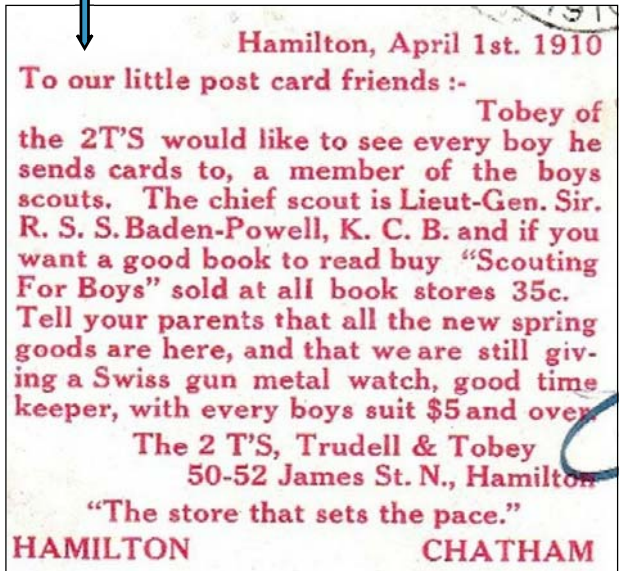

This early postcard is from a Hamilton merchant, "The 2 T's, Trudell & Tobey". Tobey dates his message April 1, but the card is postmarked March 29, 1910. He chose to use a postcard with the word "Scouts" on it ... maybe well-intentioned, but it is really military scouts with rifles aimed, entitled "Scouts Kings Dragoon Guards". This connection to the military was common, with WWI on the horizon.

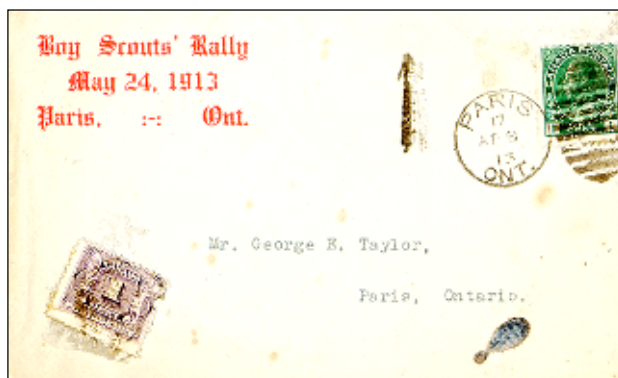
