## The Sea Scouts' Mail Adventure

.T THE END OF WORLD WARI, THE SMALL EUROPEAN COUNTRY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA DECLARED ITSELF AN INDEPENDENT NATION. IN THE GENERAL CONFUSION AND DISTRUST WHICH FOLLOWED, ALL THE COLINTRY'S RELIABLE ORGANIZATIONS WERE PRESSED INTO SERVICE FOR SPECIAL JOBS. REAT CARE WAS TAKEN TO PROTECT THE TRUE IDENTITY OF HIGH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS. ALL SUCH OFFICIALS HAD A LIST OF THE SIGNATURES OF MESSENGERS. THE SCOUT SIGNED ON THE FRONT OF THE ENVELOPE, AND THE OFFICIAL COMPARED THE SIGNATURE WITH HISLIST. AFTER REMOVING THE CONTENTS, HE SIGNED HIS NAME ON THE ENVELOPE AND RETURNED IT TO THE SCOUT AS A RECEIPT TO BE FILED AT SCOUT HEADQUARTERS.

THIS IS A TRUE STORY OF SCOUTS IN THE SERVICE OF THEIR COUNTRY. SINCE THAT FIRST SCOUT STAMP IN 1918, EIGHTY DIFFERENT COUNTRIES HAVE HONORED THEIR BOY SCOUTS AND GIRL SCOUTS WITH SPECIAL STAMPS. IN MOST CASES, THE SCOUTS HAVE EARNED THIS RECOGNITION BY PERFORMING OUTSTANDINGLY DURING TIMES OF NATIONAL EMERGENCY. SINCE WORLD WAR II, THE CZECHS HAVE AGAIN LOST THEIR FREEDOM, THIS TIME TO THE COMMUNISTS. SCOUTING IS NOT PERMITTED IN COMMUNIST-CONTROLLED COUNTRIES.
