








VIEW OF THE "LAMMERS FELDEN" PENINSULA THE JAMBOREE SITE





NORWAY POSTAL CARDS


Mint postal card issued for the Jamboree with first day of issue on 29 July 1975, the first day of the Jamboree

NORWAY POSTAL CARDS

The first attempt to have cards canceled in Oslo was met with a flat refusal. Cards could be addressed in Oslo but would be forwarded to Jamboree for cancellation and mailing. Chuck Fisk prevailed upon a clerk to strike 30 cards with the Oslo cancel. However, Chuck wasn't the only person to obtain an Oslo cancel, Although the cancel is weak, this postal card is canceled with an Oslo cancel also; albeit it is a different cancel.



NORWAY POSTAL CARDS

On this first day postal card, Chuck Fisk added a rubber-stamped Golden Bear Chapter #9, SOSSI cachet. Very few postal cards were registered. The additional stamps were necessary to pay the registration fee. This postal card did not go through the mail.





SWEDISH POST CARD

 Sweden had intended to honor the Jamboree jointly with Norway but a printing strike delayed the issuance of their stamps. They had to be content with distributing large numbers of publicity cards and taking orders at the Jamboree for delivery.



SWEDISH POST CARDS


- Two types of post cards exist.
- Type 1: Commentary in 2 languages on the bottom left and an outline for placing the stamp.
- Type 2: Commentary on the top left and no outline for the stamp.

POST OFFICE CERTIFICATE

Post Office Certificate on post card from Jamboree Post Office saying, "The postmark is proof of your visit." The rubber stamped symbol as well as two others were struck on this cover.

RETURN TO SENDER

An interesting version of our hobby is collecting mail that was accidentally or deliberately sent too late for delivery at the Jamboree. A black marker was used on this cover to denote that it was to be returned to sender. The back of the cover has a bulls-eye cancel showing the cover arrived on August 8, a day after the close of the Jamboree. It also has rubber-stamped box where reason for return is checked.



RETURN TO SENDER

A cover deliberately sent from Oslo after the Jamboree, with sufficient postage for overseas delivery. The reverse of this cover with an 11 August 1975 Lillehammer back stamp and a pasted on black and white label used to indicate the reason to Return to Sender.





SUB-CAMP ITEMS





JAMBOREE METERS

Denmark issued the earliest known pre-Jamboree slogan meter with this one dated 24 September 1974 by their co-ed Scouting Headquarters. The Norwegian Scout headquarters issued this pre-Jamboree combination of meter and rubber stamp cancel on 1 July 1975. These also were sold at the Jamboree to raise <u>money.</u>







Switzerland issued a pre-Jamboree slogan meter on 1 June 1975 at Bern.

Scotland issued a pre-Jamboree slogan meter dated 9 October 1974 at Edinburgh.








JAMBOREE METERS






JAMBOREE RADIO















The Golden Bear (Chapter #9) cachet was created by Chuck Fisk. It depicts a Grizzly Bear on a Viking ship, with runic-type script and the World Scout and Jamboree emblems.

The Pony Express Chapter #25 of Northern California created a cachet showing an enlargement of the first day cancel.


